Please use this guide to help you brainstorm your unique list of words. Note that this is just a rough guide to help you create your list. Feel free to think outside of the box and get as creative as you want. Get Creative!

Ideas and Suggestions:

Names and Dates -Include in your list your names (first, middle, last), you birthdates, and any other significant dates (anniversary, proposal date, date you met, first kiss...)

Your Story - include where and how you met (met at school, blind date, match.com, party, mutual friend...) What attracted you together? (Love of animals, beautiful eyes, sense of humor...) Things that you like to do together (sleep-in, take walks, camping, shopping, volunteering, going to church...)

Describe them - include any flattering adjectives that describe your special someone (funny, beautiful, shy, sexy, tall, outgoing, loving, caring, friendly, etc.) Go Crazy!

Describe yourself - since this is your Love Story too, be sure to include adjectives that also describe you.

"Pet" Names - Include any cute pet names that you may have for each other (sweetie, snuggle bear, stud muffin, honey, dear...)

Special Places - Where did you propose? What church do you attend? Where was your wedding? Have a special place you like to go to cuddle up? Ever make love in a strange place? Where did you go on your honeymoon? What restaurant do you go to on your anniversary?

Hobbies and Activities - List any hobbies either of you have (cooking, reading, jogging, football, golf, scrapbooking, skydiving, videogames...)

Events – any events you may have attended together or places you have travelled together (concerts, family vacations, foreign countries, theme parks...)

Favorite Things - List any favorites that either of you have. (TV Shows, Movies, Restaurants, vacation spots, food, sports teams...)

Family - Include your names and birthdates of your children and pets. What type of pets do you have? Nicknames of your children? You may also want to include other family members like your parents or their siblings if close.

Career and Professional - Where do you each work? What are your occupations? What colleges did you attend? School Mascots?

Inside Jokes - Do you have any inside jokes that only they will know about. Are there any cute, embarrassing stories that would make them laugh?

Remember: These ideas are just a guideline. Try to think of any word or phrase that might rekindle a special memory or bring a smile to their face. You know your relationship, now PROVE IT to them!
